

## Import publications in ZORA

You will need the bibliographic data for each publication you record in ZORA, which varies according to the type of publication. However, to make things easier, you can import the bibliographic data.

Log in to ZORA and access «My ZORA».



The submission form is divided into different sections. When importing a publication, most of them will be automatically filled in.

- **Upload files:** add a PDF of the publication (published version or accepted manuscript) using «browse» or «drag & drop».


Some sections are hidden by default. To display them, scroll to the bottom of the submission form and click «Add more». Here you can select the section(s) you want to add.

### Uncontrolled keywords – what's new


Keywords are now displayed differently

It is also possible to add a list of keywords. This only works if the keywords are separated by commas.

## Importing with DOI / PubMed

At the bottom of the submission form, it is possible to :

- Discard = deletes the entry
- Save = saves and remains in the form (it has an auto-save function, saving automatically every minute)
- Save for later = saves and closes the form (entry can be edited again later)
- Deposit = sends the record to the review process. There it will be checked and approved by the central ZORA editorial team or the ZORA editors.

## Importing with DOI / PubMed

Your submissions can have three different status:

Archived: the publication is in the live archive.

Workflow: the publication is in the review process and will be checked by an editor before being published in the live archive.

Workspace: the publication hasn't been deposited yet and you can still edit it before depositing it.

## Importing with DOI / PubMed

If you try to import a publication that is already in the live archive, you will get a duplicate message. By clicking on the message “The system has identified some potential duplicates”, you can add your institute / clinic to the record.
